



STUDIO MONITOR ART RESIDENCY

THE PROGRAM:

The SRISA Studio Monitor Art Residency provides the opportunity for young artists to continue developing their personal body of work while at the same time gaining valuable experience in a role of responsibility within an artistic, academic setting.

The recipient will be provided with full access to the SRISA studios (outside of scheduled class hours) which hosts state of the art printmaking, photography, book binding, fashion design, 3D sculpture, painting, and drawing facilities. In addition, the recipient will have the option to take (1) SRISA course per term with waived tuition. The recipient will be invited to exhibit artwork completed during the residency towards the termination of the program.

In exchange for these opportunities, the recipient of the Studio Monitor Art Residency will be responsible for helping keep the main administrative and studio art campuses open in the evenings and over the weekends. The Monitor is responsible for opening and closing the school and monitoring the people that enter and leave the premises. Additional requests may include assisting in the studios, on housing checkin, and during SRISA extra-curricular events. Monitors typically work 10-20 hours per week depending on the schedule, calendar and events. Schedules are assigned at the beginning of each month.

The Studio Monitor Art Residency is a one-year position beginning either with the Fall or Spring academic semesters. A limited number of residents will be selected each year.

Note: This is not a paid residency. Residents are financially responsible for themselves during their stay. Residents will need to make their own housing arrangements, but are welcome to take advantage of SRISA housing options if they wish.

THE CANDIDATE:

The candidate must have received his or her Bachelor of Arts before the start of the residency.

- 10 Images of artwork along with: Title / Date / Dimensions / Media
- Letter of Intent: explain why you would like to take part in the Studio Monitor Art Residency at the Santa Reparata International School of Art, the project you would like to develop during your residency, and what you feel you can contribute to the SRISA community
