MERIT BASED SCHOLARSHIPS SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- SRISA Enrollment application (click [here](#) for online form)
- SRISA Scholarship application
- Official academic transcript (a minimum 3.0 GPA is required for merit based scholarships)
- Minimum two (2) professional reference letters
- Resume/Curriculum Vitae
- Personal Statement: minimum 300 words detailing why you feel you are a strong candidate, what you hope to gain from the study abroad experience, and how SRISA can contribute to your long-term goals
- Artistic samples (10 images, resolution 72dpi) of your most recent artwork, for Fine Art and Design applicants. Include a description, size, and medium for each image.
- Original Essay, 3-5 pages in length, for Non-Studio Art applicants. Themes: Art History, Design Theory or Concepts, New Media, Marketing and Communication, Leadership, History or Cultural Studies. If a recent term paper, provide a brief description of assignment for which it was written. Plagiarism will not be condoned.

NEED BASED SCHOLARSHIPS SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum two (2) professional reference letters
- Resume/Curriculum Vitae
- Personal Statement: minimum 300 words detailing why you feel you are a strong candidate, what you hope to gain from the study abroad experience, and how SRISA can contribute to your long-term goals
- Statement of Financial Need demonstrating that study abroad would not be possible without a scholarship. This may include family income, number of household members, or other circumstances that may play a role in your financial situation.
- FAFSA SAR Report (for US citizens and permanent residents)
- For non-US citizens, non-US permanent residents, or students for which a FAFSA does not apply, a notarized document stating family income in relation to your nationality's cost of living and average income/poverty level.

- Minimum two (2) professional reference letters
- Resume/Curriculum Vitae
- Personal Statement: minimum 300 words detailing why you feel you are a strong candidate, what you hope to gain from the study abroad experience, and how SRISA can contribute to your long-term goals
- Statement of Diversity: minimum 300 words about how any of the following topics have been relevant to your life: diversity in ethnic and racial groups, first generation college students, gender, sexual orientation, disability, age, military status, etc.

If applying for more than one SRISA scholarship, a complete application packet must be submitted for each individual scholarship.
